Canadian Angus Association Presents First Feedlot of the Year Award to High Ridge Feeders and Shannondale Farm

CALGARY, AB — High Ridge Feeders and Shannondale Farm of Manitoba received the Canadian Angus Association's first Feedlot of the Year award in recognition of their work feeding and promoting Angus and Angus cross cattle.

CEO Doug Fee presented the award to Ed and Glori Dalke of High Ridge Feeders and Harry and Brenda Dalke of Shannondale Farm at the Canadian Angus Association's annual general meeting banquet on Saturday, June 11.

The Dalke families had no idea that they would be receiving an award and made touching acceptance speeches about how surprised and humbled they were by the honour. They said that they use Angus cattle because they provide good results in the feedlot, and that they tremendously enjoy working with Angus breeders.

The Canadian Angus Association introduced the Feedlot the Year award this year to recognize feedlots that promote Angus to their customers and that feed Canadian Angus Rancher Endorsed tagged cattle.

The Canadian Angus Association is Canada's largest purebred beef breed organization. The Association represents 3,000 members across Canada for the purposes of registering and recording the pedigrees of purebred Angus cattle in the closed Herd Book and promoting the breed across Canada. The member-approved mandate is to maintain breed registry, breed purity and provide services that enhance the growth and position of the Angus breed.
