Canadian Angus Foundation Announces Junior Heifer Voucher Recipients

Rocky View County, AB—Three Canadian Junior Angus members will each receive \$2,000 heifer vouchers from the Canadian Angus Foundation just for being members of Canada’s largest beef breed’s junior program.

Layne Chantler of Egbert, Ontario; Grace Glover of Boissevain, Manitoba; and Karsen Van Sickle of Red Deer County, Alberta were randomly drawn from all Canadian Junior Angus members. The heifer voucher can be used toward the purchase of an Angus female of the youth’s choice this fall.

To be eligible for the heifer voucher draw, youths with an interest in Canadian Angus had to purchase or renew a CJA membership on or before October 1. A random draw was conducted to select the winners.

“One of the Canadian Angus Foundation’s main objectives is to support youth development. It is gratifying to be able to offer members of our junior program the opportunity to expand their herds thanks to the generous support of our donors,” says Canadian Angus Foundation Executive Director and Canadian Junior Angus Coordinator Belinda Wagner. “The Foundation’s board of directors looks forward to seeing which female each recipient chooses.”
