

BCAA Angus Cash Jackpot Pen Show

Saturday, September 30, 2023 @ Alex Fraser Park, Quesnel, BC

Pen Show Starts at 3:00 PM

Entry Fee: \$60.00

- per entry, per class (limited two entries per class per contributor)

Cash Payout:

- \$300.00 and BCAA gift for each Class Champion
- \$150.00 and BCAA gift for each Class Reserve Champion

Rules:

- All purebred animals must be registered in the exhibitor's name to be eligible to show
- All purebred entries must be legibly tattooed. All entries must have CCIA tags
- All exhibitors are responsible for their own feed, cleaning of pens and water troughs. Water will be provided.
- No clipping of livestock on the grounds (clipping is optional. Must be done prior to arriving)
- Wet brush only - No foams, adhesives or use of blowers
- All cattle must be on the grounds by 10:30 am - September 30
- Cattle may be halter broke (optional - not a requirement)

Judges:

- Judging will be conducted by a three person panel

Jackpot Pen Classes:

- 201 Pen of (2) two purebred registered Black or Red Angus calendar year bull calves
- 202 Pen of (2) two purebred registered Black or Red Angus calendar year heifer calves
- 203 Pen of (2) two purebred registered Black or Red Angus yearling (2022) bred heifers
- 204 Pen of (2) strong Angus Black or Red yearling commercial (2022) bred heifers
- 205 Purebred Black or Red Angus registered cow / calf pair
Cows may be any age. Calves must be calendar year. Male or female.
NOTE: Calves may also be shown in classes 201 or 202.
- 206 Commercial cow / calf pairs of any age to be shown as a pair. Calves may be male or female. Both the cow and calf must have strong Black or Red Angus traits.
