

Step-by-Step INSTRUCTIONS

How to Use the New Canadian Angus Association Digital Calving Book App

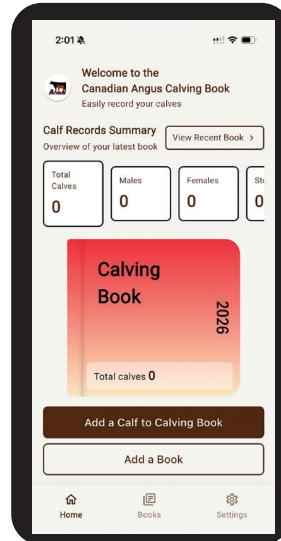


STEP 1

Download the Canadian Angus Calving Book from the Apple Store or Google Play. This technology has been developed to bring added value to Canadian Angus members, therefore there is no cost to download the app, however a CAA account is required to use the app.

STEP 2

Create your account log in using your Canadian Angus Association primary member ID. If you don't know your primary member ID, please contact the office for help. You will be required to choose a password (minimum 8 characters). You can have multiple devices logged into this account (using your primary ID and chosen password) to access the same calving books.



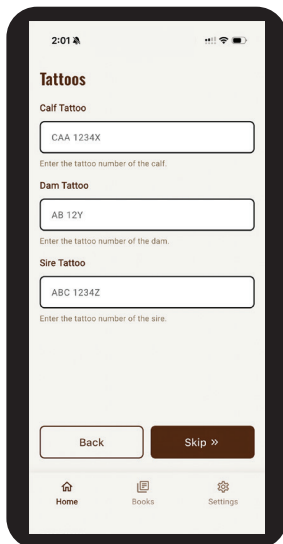
STEP 3

Create a Calving Book by tapping **Add a Book**. This will open the create a new book screen where you can add a calving book title and year. You must indicate 2026 for your 2026 Cow Inventory to load.

Please note: you don't need your inventory to be loaded to use the app, you can just type in the names manually.

STEP 4

Once your calving book is created, tap on the book to open it.

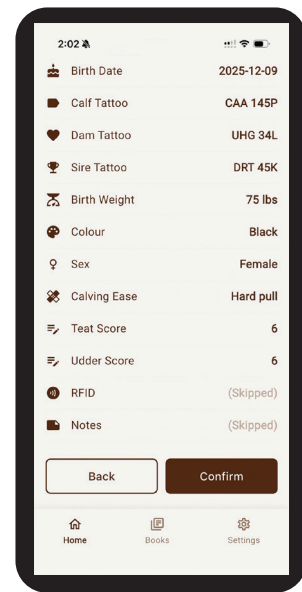


STEP 5

To create a new calf record, click **Add a Calf to Calving Book** and enter the calf information including date of birth, calf tattoo, dam tattoo, sire tattoo, birth weight, birth weight management group, coat colour, calf sex, calving ease code, teat and udder score for the dam, CCIA RFID number and any notes you would like to record for the calf. You can skip any field you wish to leave empty.

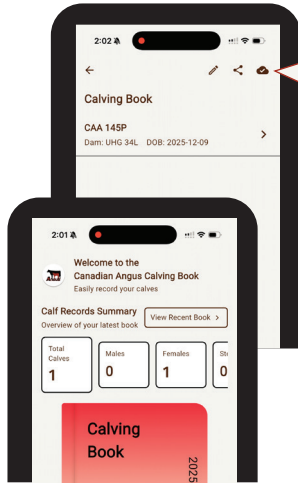
STEP 6

Once you've gone through all the information screens the next page will summarize the information and allow you to check your records. If everything looks as expected, tap **Confirm** or your record won't be saved in your calving book.



STEP 7

All calf records will be listed in your calving book and summarized on the home page.

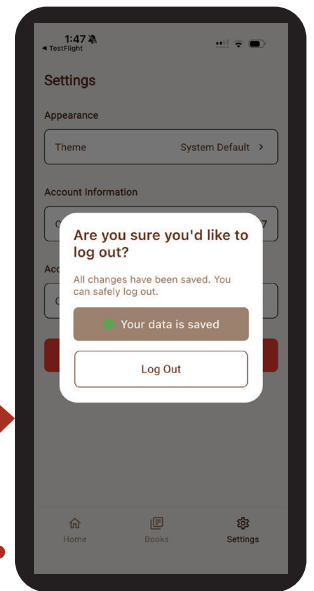


This share icon allows you to email yourself a copy, as a backup for your records.

This cloud icon confirms that all info is synced. If you do not see this symbol, wait until you are on a network and synced before logging out.

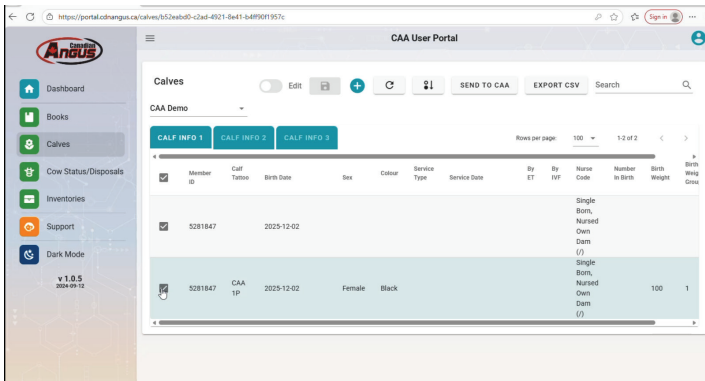
STEP 8

The app will also confirm your data is saved when you're logging out.



STEP 9

You can access your calf records on your computer using our calving app registration portal (www.portal.cdnangus.ca) Here you can enter any missing information required for registration purposes and submit your application for registrations electronically.



STEP 10

Multiple users logging in to the Canadian Angus Calving Book App with the same log in information, can access the calving book. So, if your night shift person recorded five new calves overnight, your day shift person will be able to access these records in the morning, using the same log in information in the Canadian Angus Calving Book App.

STEP 11

Please note that under **Customize** you have the option to delete a book. If there are calf records in your book and you delete the calving book—those calf records will be lost.
