The intermediate division (ages 13–16) champion was Kate Albrecht of Holden, AB and Wynton Brandl of Jarvie, AB won reserve champion.

Champion in the senior division (age 17–21) was awarded to Shae Wasyliw of High River, AB and reserve champion was Robert Geis of Barrhead, AB.

In the Farm Sign Competition, Juniors prepare their sign before the show and judging takes place over the entire weekend. The judge circulates through the barns and evaluates the farm signs that are displayed in the stalls. The participants are judged on their originality, creativity and display of their farm sign. This year's judge was Mark Holowaychuk.

Canadian Junior Angus is a group of Angus enthusiasts under the age of 21. Showdown is an annual summer cattle show organized by Canadian Junior Angus. It rotates to provinces throughout the country every July. Due to the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic and travel challenges, this year events were offered both in person and virtually. 105 participants and 100 head of cattle took part in the 21st annual Showdown in Olds, Alberta.
