Foundation Legacy Scholarship

Awarded by the Canadian Angus Foundation

The Canadian Angus Foundation functions to preserve and expand the Angus breed for future generations through education, youth development, scientific and market research, and historical preservation and restoration. The Canadian Angus Foundation was incorporated in 1993 and is the charitable arm of the Canadian Angus Association.

Awards totaling \$11,000 will be presented to Canadian Junior Angus members, recognizing overall academic achievement, leadership and community involvement, and industry knowledge. Awards in the amount of \$5,000, \$3,000, \$2,000 and \$500 for the runners-up will be presented.

To be considered for the award, complete and return this application to the Canadian Angus Foundation by January 5.

Applicant qualifications:

1. Applicants must be a member of Canadian Junior Angus.
2. Applicants must be in their final year of high school or already enrolled in college or post secondary education at the time of the application deadline.
3. Top five applicants selected must participate in an interview and moderated panel discussion at the GOAL Conference in Saskatoon, SK February 15-17, 2025.
4. All applications must be typed. No handwritten applications will be accepted.
5. Applications must be submitted by email to Belinda Wagner at bwagner@cdnangus.ca with the subject line reading "Foundation Legacy Scholarship".
6. Awards will be selected on the following scale: 20% application; 20% academic achievement; 25% personal interview; 25% moderated panel discussion performance, 10% social media presence.

Complete application to include:

1. Cover sheet with name, contact information and CAA ID number.
2. Résumé to include but not limited to CJA involvement, community activities, school involvement and achievement, and leadership activities.
3. Current high school or secondary education transcript along with a current photo must be submitted.
4. Submit a 250-500 word essay on your educational program of choice and future career goals.
5. Selected winners will be required to submit proof of enrollment prior to receiving the scholarship.
