



Instructions for Completing the Female Exposure and Disposal Worksheet

This spreadsheet is available for members to submit their breeding and female disposal records. Female breeding records go toward the HPG EPD and ensuring the accuracy of subsequent calf pedigrees. Female disposal records go toward the HPG EPD and the Cow Longevity EPD. It is imperative that the spreadsheet is completed in the correct format to avoid processing delays and to receive EPDs.

Column A – Association – Always CANG DO NOT CHANGE this information

Column B – Member ID – This is your CAA membership ID number

Column C – Cow Tattoo – Enter the complete tattoo in the correct format (CAA 1234J)

Column D – Cow Rego No – Enter the cow registration number

Column E – Disposal Code (1-10) – enter only the number, no words or letters

- o 1 - died – disease
- o 2 - died – age
- o 3 - died – other
- o 4 - culled - physical defect
- o 5 - culled – fertility
- o 6 - culled – performance
- o 7 - culled – temperament
- o 8 - culled – age
- o 9 - sold for breeding – no registration papers transferred
- o 10 – sold for breeding – transfer forthcoming

Column F – Disposal Date (yyyymmdd) – use this date format 20211231 – must be 4 digits for the year; 2 digits for month; and 2 digits for day. Must be numbers only; do not use symbols such as - /

Column G – AI Sire Tattoo – complete tattoo for the AI sire. If the cow has more than one AI service please add a row at the bottom of the worksheet to add in the additional AI services.

Column H – AI Date (yyyymmdd) – use this date format 20211231 – must be 4 digits for the year; 2 digits for month; and 2 digits for day. Must be numbers only; do not use symbols such as - /

Column I - AI Management Group - Indicate if all females were managed the same and had the same opportunity to conceive

Column J - Natural Sire Tattoo (1) – enter the complete tattoo for the sire. If the cow is exposed to up to 3 sires with the same exposure dates, enter the additional sires in Natural Sire 2 and Natural Sire 3.

Column K - Natural Sire Tattoo (2) – enter the complete tattoo for the second sire with the same exposure date as the first sire.

Column L – Natural Sire Tattoo (3) – enter the complete tattoo for the third sire with the same exposure date.

- o If you have 4 or more sires with the same exposure date, please add a row to the bottom of the spreadsheet with additional sire information
- o If you have more than one natural service date, the additional sires with different natural service dates need to be added to the bottom of the spreadsheet.

Column M – Natural Start Date (yyyymmdd) – This is the date that you turned the bull out with the cow. Use this date format 20211231 – must be 4 digits for the year; 2 digits for month; and 2 digits for day. Must be numbers only; do not use symbols such as - /

Column N - Natural End Date (yyyymmdd) - This is the date that you pulled the bull from the cow. Use this date format 20211231 – must be 4 digits for the year; 2 digits for month; and 2 digits for day. Must be numbers only; do not use symbols such as - /

Column O - Natural Management Group - Indicate if all females were managed the same and had the same opportunity to conceive
