There are multiple options for accommodations. Room blocks were unable to be secured, however Oromocto is 30 minutes from the venue in a straight shot highway manner- and Fredericton has many options just a short way beyond that. There is lots of space at the farm if you want to bring a travel trailer or tent (and the barn does have a shower that can be used if needed) also as cottages that are nearby (though it is a long weekend in NB- keep in mind). AirBnB has a few cottage options as well. Sussex is about equal distance away- though the highway driving towards Fredericton makes for an easy drive.

There is a collaborative Pasture Improvement Bus Tour that is an add on event for anyone who would like to join while the Juniors are doing their meeting, judging, and trivia events on Saturday afternoon. Full itinerary to come- but seats will be limited so if you plan on coming please pre-register.

For the Junior Heifer Show, move in will be required to be completed by noon on Saturday August 2nd, and departure will be allowed at the conclusion of the Junior Show on Sunday. The barns will be available for move-in starting anytime on Friday August 1st, and if you would like to take advantage of the NB and NS long weekend, you are free to stay until Monday the 4th if you wish- just make arrangements with Joe and Crystal!

The entry form for participating Juniors can be done through a Microsoft Forms Link. Please be sure to have your Junior Membership paid up by the entry deadline! Junior members must be between 9 and 21 years of age on December 31, 2024. There will be classes for both Purebred and Commercial (min 50% Angus) heifers born in 2025 and 2024. Mother/Nurse cows are welcome too, but please note that need in the appropriate spot in the entry form.

REGISTRATION COSTS- \$75 for the Full Weekend, \$45 for One Day Saturday, \$35 for One Day Sunday, and a \$20 Add on for all those attending the Pasture Improvement Tours. JUNIOR EXHIBITORS will be \$50 for the Full Weekend. All Meals are included in this pricing. Pre-registration is appreciated, and fees will be collected upon arrival (Cash, Cheque, E-transfer)

Junior Show Rules and Regulations

LOGISTICS

- Arrival Time with your animals is between 8am and noon on Saturday August 2nd. IF you would like to move in on the 1st- that can be arranged. Please contact one of the Barn Bosses listed **BARN BOSSES:** (506)440-0300 Joseph/(506) 440-7686 Crystal
- Generators are encouraged
- Bedding will be provided. You are responsible for all other supplies. If you need to purchase hay, contact the Barn Bosses.
- There is no per heifer entry fee, but there will be a Junior Exhibitor fee of \$50 which will cover all meals and the T-shirt. This fee will be collected upon arrival/registration desk.
- NOTE- Junior, Intermediate, and Senior will have Aggregate winners announced: This is a compilation of points from ALL of the activities! There will be a nice Bonus for these awards.
- There will be a fundraising auction and families of Junior participants are asked to bring an item to contribute towards that. The proceeds of this largely go back to the Junior Exhibitors

SHOW RULES

- Exhibitors must be a junior, annual or life member of the Canadian Angus Association at the time of the field Day.
- Eligible juniors must be between 9 and 21 as of December 31, 2024.
- Show day apparel for the Conformation and Showmanship classes will be the Field Day Shirt (provided with registration), and Blue Jeans. Please wear appropriate hard soled footwear (no Crocs or sandals in the show ring)
- Exhibitors may only show one animal per division. Substitutes may be accommodated for cause
- The Electronic Registration Form www.forms.office.com/r/ymvk70P0uc
- Purebred animals must have registration numbers provided and tattoos will be checked once all heifers are on site Saturday.
- Animals entered in the commercial division must show Angus characteristics. A committee will be designated to assess the significance of Angus influence in commercial entries. The committee has the power and duty to disqualify any animals deemed to be showing very little or no Angus influence. The committee's decision is final.
- Each exhibitor must submit a copy of their farm/animal liability insurance.
- No paint Products allowed as per CAA resolution where CAA provides grant \$
- Entries will be listed in the show catalogue in the order of animals age, and will be led into the ring in catalogue order. Classes may be split depending on the number of entries.

Junior Show Rules and Regulations

JUDGING COMPETITION- Individual

- Score considerations- Logic for Reasons Given (60%)
 - Placing compared to official (40%)
- Participants will individually judge a single class of 4 animals.
- Pee Wee & Junior will place the class and give reasons to judge
- Intermediate & Senior will place the class and provide written reasons on card provided to them.

PHOTOGRAPHY COMPETITION- PHOTO SUBMISSION BY July 24 for pre-judging

Note: Photographs in each division become the sole property of CJA and may be used for promotional or other purposes by CJA or the CAA

Score considerations- Clarity (40%)

- Quality (35%)
- Originality (25%)

- Only one entry per exhibitor and the photograph must be taken by the Junior exhibiting it
- Photographs must be 4" x 6" and submitted via email to maritimeangus@gmail.com prior to July 24th for pre-judging.
- Photographs must be entered in one of the following categories:
 - a. Angus Animal - focus of the picture is an Angus animal(s)
 - b. Angus Scenery - focus of the picture is split between the Angus animals and the background/ location of the photo
 - c. Angus Animals and People - focus of the pictures -Angus animals and people
- Photography entries will be on display at the show. All categories will be judged together.

TEAM TRIVIA

- Participants will be placed on a Trivia Team
- The rules of the Trivia will be provided by the Quizmaster prior to the Trivia competition beginning.
